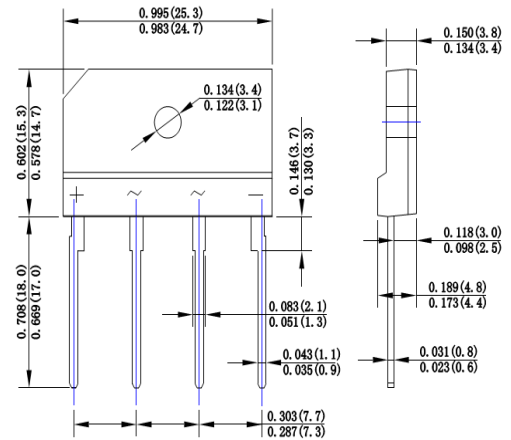

FIG. 1- DERATING CURVE OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

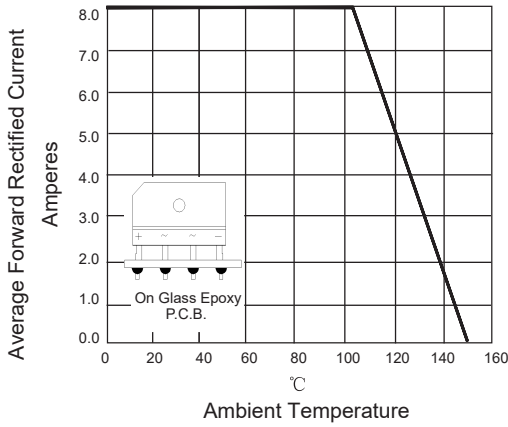


FIG. 2-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER LEG

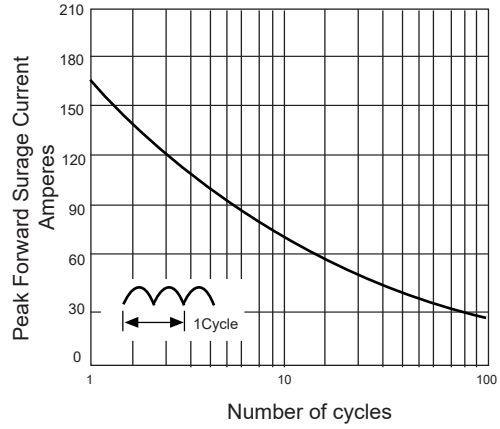


FIG. 3-TYPICAL FORWARD VOLTAGE CHARACTERISTICS

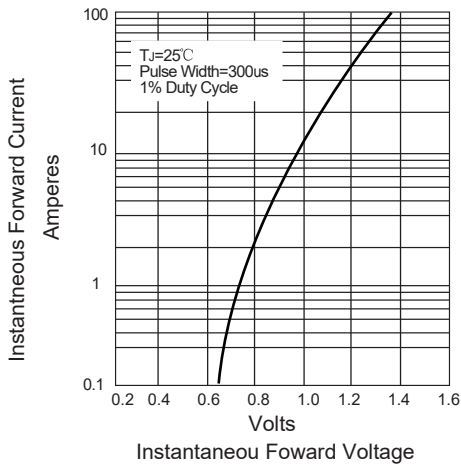
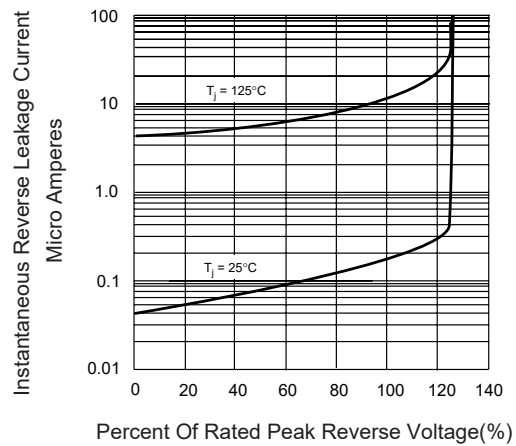
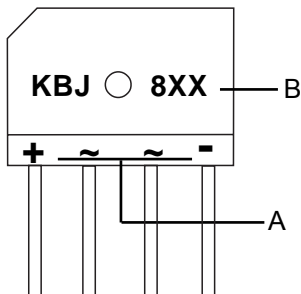


FIG. 4-TYPICAL REVERSE LEAKAGE CHARACTERISTICS



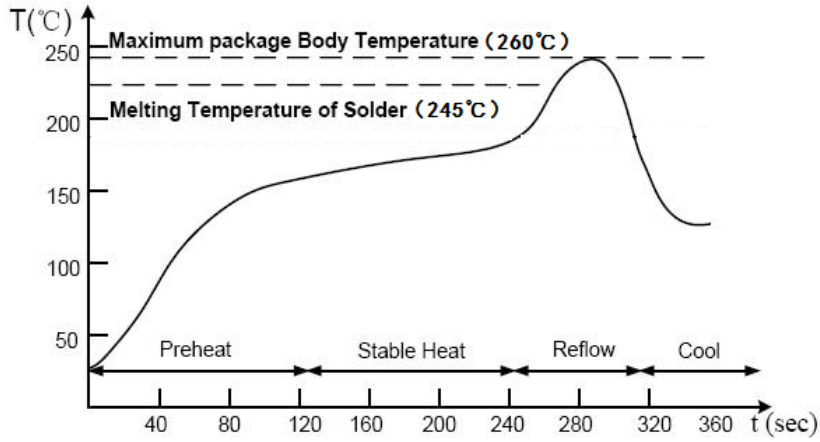

## Suggested Soldering Temperature Profile



### Note

- Recommended reflow methods: IR, vapor phase oven, hot air oven, wave solder.
- The device can be exposed to a maximum temperature of 260°C for 10 seconds.
- Devices can be cleaned using standard industry methods and solvents.
- If reflow temperatures exceed the recommended profile, devices may not meet the performance requirements.
